How do I submit my **FREE** application?

From 2009, both commencing and continuing students will need to apply for the Equity Scholarships online via the Queensland Tertiary Admissions Centre (QTAC) website. It's free—and easier than you think:

Step 1.

Start by going online to QTAC www.qtac.edu.au.

Step 2.

Go to the 'Scholarships' tab (at the top of the page) and complete the online scholarship application form. If you have any scholarship questions, contact the QUT Equity Section on 07 3138 5601 or email equityscholarships@qut.edu.au

Step 3.

You will find out if you are successful in mid-January 2009. If you are offered a scholarship, you will be required to submit documentation to support the claims you made in your online application.

Please note: There is only one form to fill out and there is no fee to submit your scholarship application via the QTAC website – it's free!

When?

Online scholarship applications will be available on the QTAC website from late August 2008 and should be lodged by the end of October 2008. On-time applications will boost your chances of success – so hop to it!

What's on offer?

At QUT there are hundreds of Commonwealth Scholarships and hundreds of QUT-funded scholarships (including bursaries) available each year, ranging in value from \$1,000 to \$4,400 for low-income students.

For more information on all of the scholarships available to low-income students, visit scholarships.qut.com. While you're there, you can also check out QUT's complete range of scholarships.

If you've ever thought about applying for a scholarship (even if you're in your third or fourth year!), now's your chance – just apply before the end of October.

If you currently receive an Equity Scholarship or Bursary (and you plan to continue studying at QUT in 2009), you will need to reapply before the end of October.

If you currently receive a Commonwealth Scholarship, you don't need to reapply – unless of course, your scholarship is expiring and you'd like to apply for an Equity Scholarship or Bursary – which you'll need to do before (you guessed it!) the end of October.
